

Distance Learning Set Up For Online Music Lessons

Here are a few tips for having the best experience for your online lessons

Your PLAY ZONE

Try to set up in a part of your home where you'll have the fewest distractions. In addition to your Computer, laptop or Tablet, here are some good things to have:

1. Desk or Table to set your computer/laptop/tablet on
2. Music Stand (or something that can help prop up your lesson book or mobile device)
3. Pencil so you can write teacher tips in your music book or assignment notebook
4. Comfy armless chair for sitting

OTHER HELP ITEMS

5. Instrument stand to rest your instrument in when you're not holding it
6. Headphones (wired or wireless connected to your computer/laptop/tablet to hear better)
7. USB microphone (connected to your computer/laptop/tablet for better audio quality)
8. Table lamp or lighting facing towards you for a clear picture. **TIP:** For rooms with windows make sure you are set up facing the window. Lighting from behind you will make you appear dark so you will want to set up facing the window so that your teacher can see you well.
