BLM: Please describe your business and the goods and services you offer. What is your business philosophy? How long have you been in business? Why did you choose to locate your business in Moscow?

GTR: I started GTR Music Studio in 1993, the last year of my graduate degree at the UI Hampton School of Music (Masters in guitar performance). I loved living in the community and wanted to continue teaching and sharing the knowledge and skills I had acquired there with people in the community that wanted to learn more about music and how to play an instrument. Initially it just started with guitar and bass instruction. Since then it has grown to include piano, voice, drums, ukulele, and trumpet. I set out to multiply my passion of how music should be taught by assembling a teaching staff who are talented, qualified, and that share my same philosophy of music education.

My goal is that every student receives individual music instruction, tailored to their age, personality, and learning style in a fun and engaging way. I carefully select teachers that will emulate this goal. I was fortunate to study with some incredible music faculty at the U of I who were more like mentors in the way that their teaching connected to me personally. They had a way of making their subject matter interesting and relevant in a holistic way. That approach is what inspired my teaching philosophy.

I'm also committed to supporting a community that has supported us and helped us grow by giving back in the form of donations to community events, partnerships, and scholarships.

BLM: How would you characterize the business climate in Moscow? Is this community supportive of local business? How do you think it might change in the future?

GTR: Moscow has always struck me as unique in the way that the community and university/student community seem to support each other. I think there's a better awareness of and support for small, local and independent businesses in a way that you don't find in other towns this size, let alone many larger towns. I believe the buy local movement and Buy Local Moscow organization specifically have been instrumental in raising that awareness.
